A new version of the Law of the Republic of Uzbekistan “On Education” has been adopted on September 23, 2020 y. № LRU-637

Resolution of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan “On measures for the further development of the higher education system” dated on April 20, 2017 y. № RP-2909

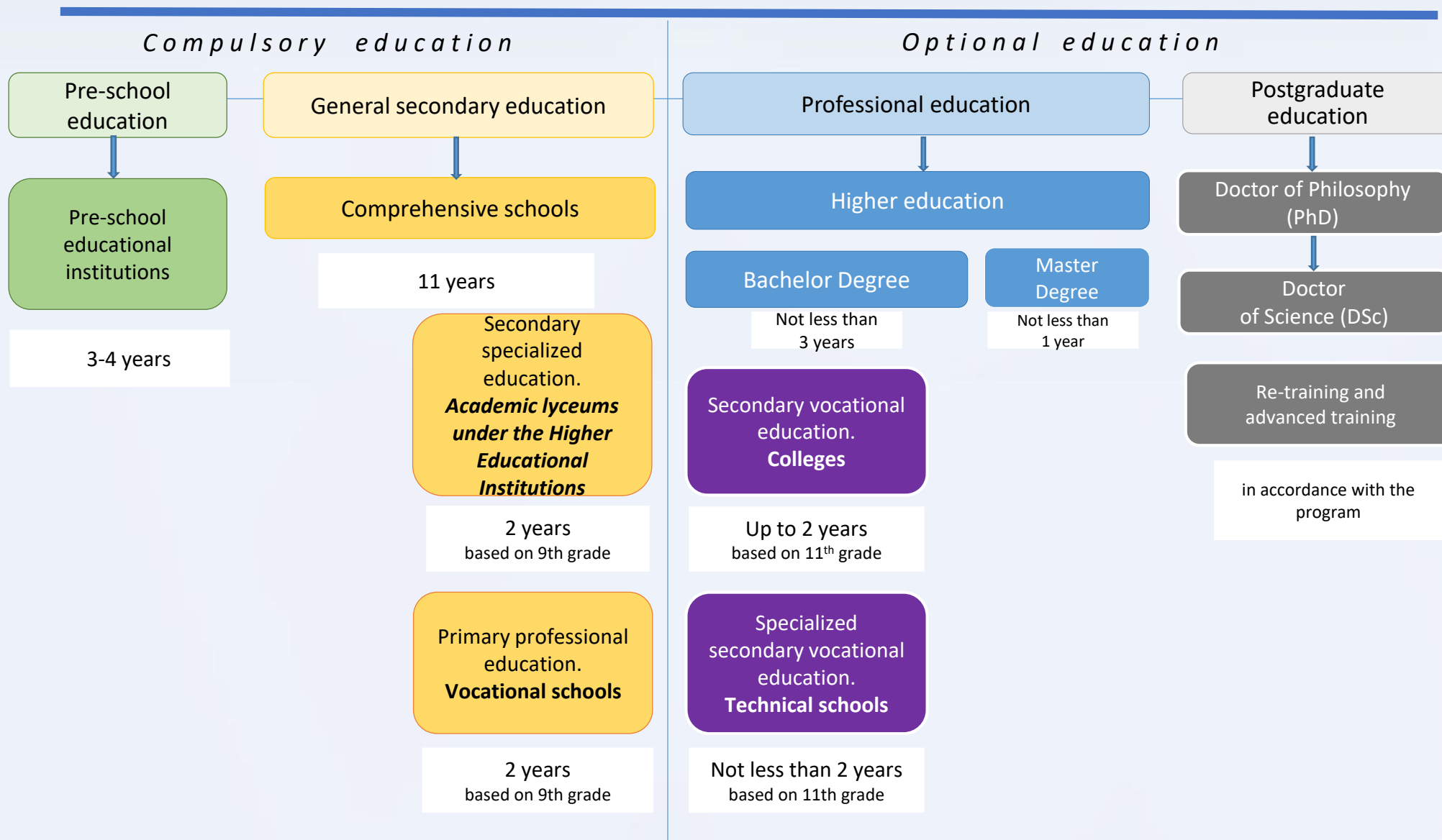

COOPERATION WITH FOREIGN UNIVERSITIES

The personnel training courses based on foreign universities' education programmes were implemented in 24 higher education institutions of our republic.

During the last 4 years total 16 branches, 22 joint faculties and launch 282 double/joint degree programmes has been established together with the foreign universities.

HIGHER EDUCATION REFORMS IN UZBEKISTAN

The Concept of development of higher education of the Republic of Uzbekistan till 2030

1

Granting universities the right to independently develop and approve curricula and programs. Reduction of social and humanitarian subjects and increase in the volume of subjects of specialization, as well as educational and practical training in curricula.

2

Phased transition from rating to credit-modular system of organization of the educational process.

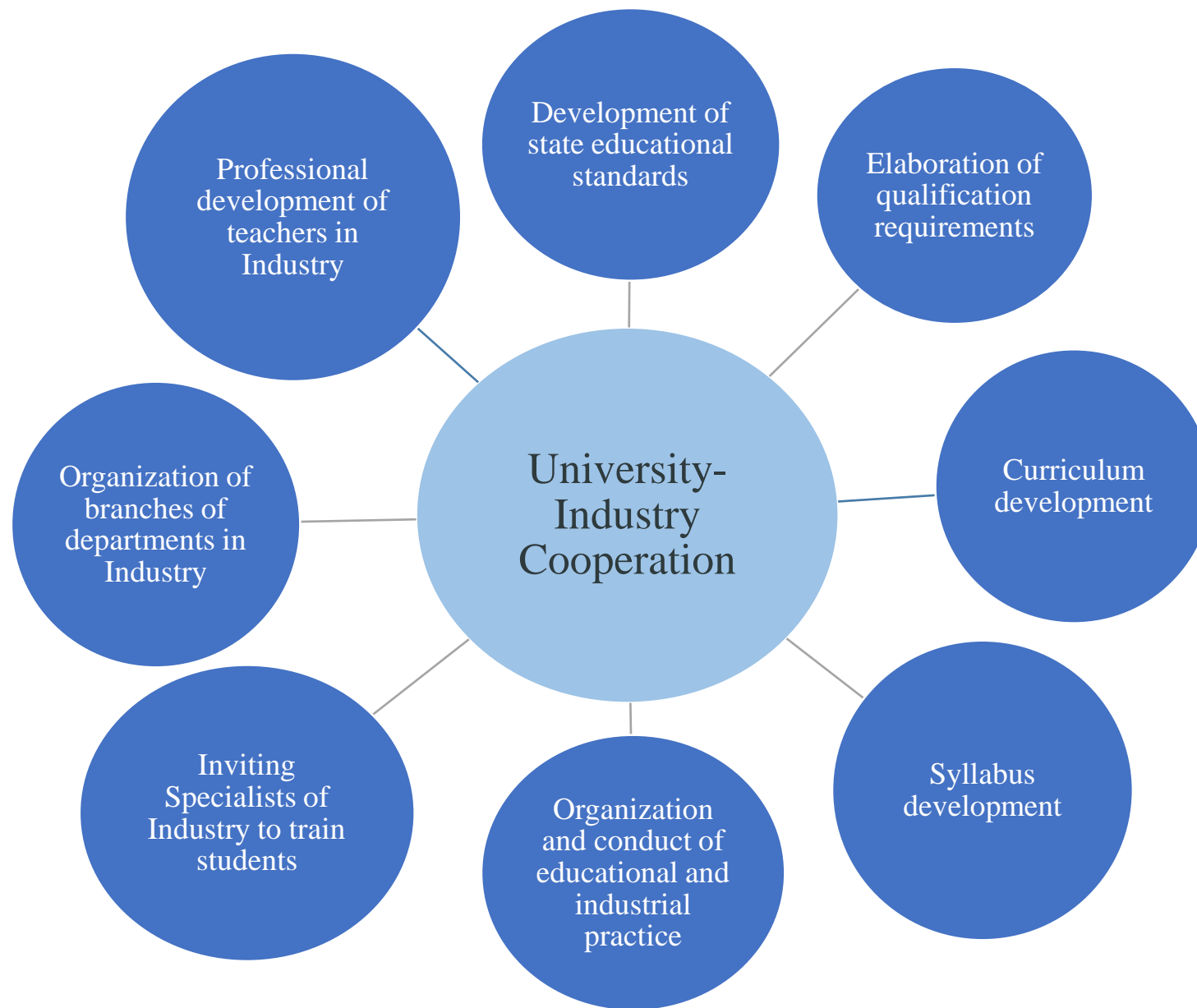

Active involvement of Industry employers in the preparation of educational standards, qualification requirements, curricula and programs of higher and secondary specialized vocational education.

4

The implementation of the concept "University 3.0" providing close connection of education, science, innovations and activities for commercialization of results of scientific research in the highest educational institutions

The transition from theoretical education to a system, aimed at developing practical skills



COOPERATION WITH EUROPEAN UNION IN THE REFORM OF HIGHER EDUCATION

creation of joint educational programs aimed at the introduction of a modern education system, providing for a close connection of the education process with industrial practice and scientific research

participation in new projects of the EU educational program Erasmus + during 2021-2027 on the introduction of European standards of education in the higher education system

Fostering Research and Development in the HEIs based on strategy development of Uzbekistan using technical assistance of EU funding resources

provision of assistance from the EU (allocation of quotas or an increase in scholarships) in the training of graduates of bachelor's and master's degrees from universities in Uzbekistan in master and doctoral studies in European universities
