Management of the international student/staff exchange



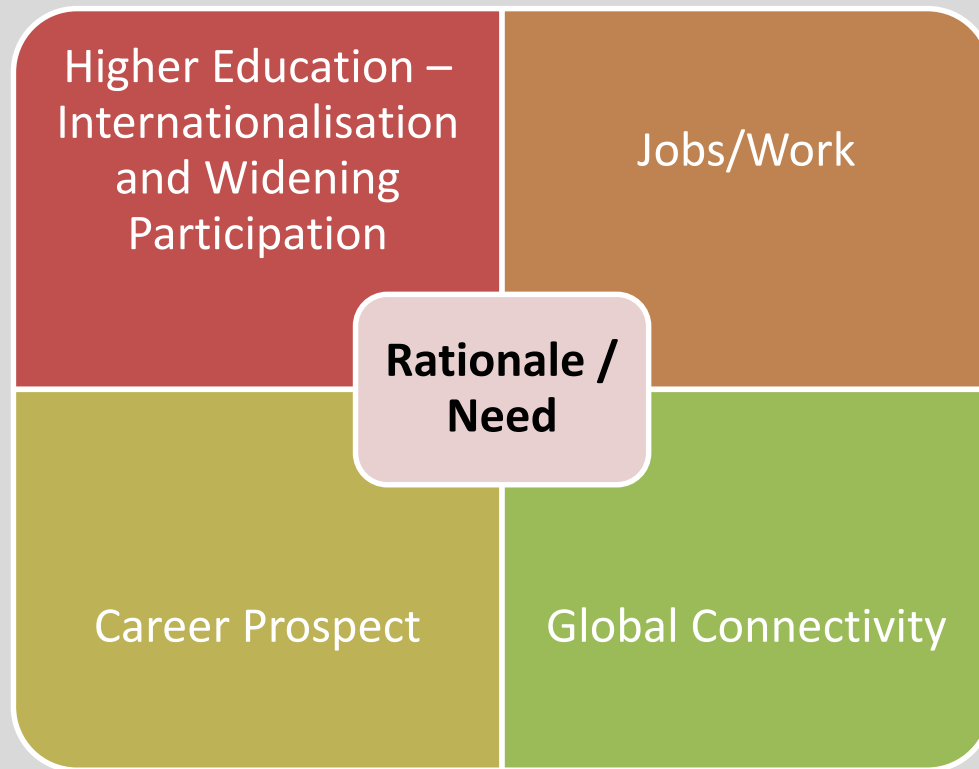
- Different visa procedures for different EU countries and long lasting
- EU universities have difficulties to accommodate larger number of international students
- Not all EU universities are offering studies in English language or the offer is limited to few Master programs
- The extensive bureaucracy connected to one student mobility

Challenges towards quality in Central Asia region

- Students and staff involved with insufficient language knowledge and/or no expertise
- No control and follow up after mobility at home university
- Mobility used by university authorities as bonus
- Academic mobility is used more for tourism purposes

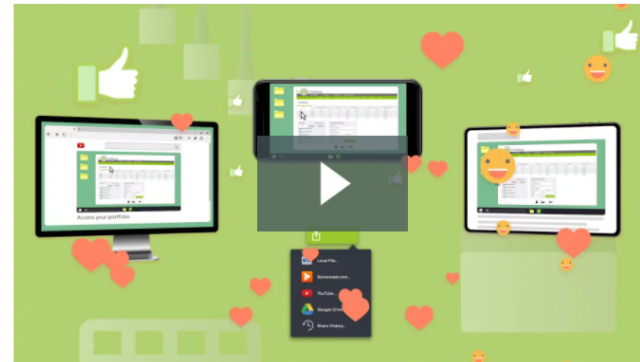


